## FAMILIES ARE WELCOME TO ATTEND THE CONCERT PERFORMANCE!

But you will not be allowed to view the Sight-Reading performance for confidentiality purposes.

Please arrive at the auditorium at least 20 minutes before our Concert Performance time to ensure you will be able to view the performance. When a Choir is on stage, the doors will be closed and audience members will be strongly discouraged from entering or exiting the auditorium.

## IMPORTANT: UIL Auditorium Etiquette. Please read carefully!

- The judges' job is to listen carefully to all the details of a performance to give an accurate rating. If there are noises and distractions they cannot do their job properly.
- You must be completely SILENT during a performance so as not to distract the judges. (Phone and camera sounds should be turned off, and talking or whispering is not appropriate. Also, if a small child or infant is making noises, they may need to be removed from the auditorium by a parent.)
- You may only clap at the beginning of a performance, and then again at the end, after all three pieces have been performed. We encourage our students to use the sign language "applause" gesture to show their appreciation to the Choirs on stage between the first two songs to avoid making any noise.
- Anybody not abiding by these rules may be asked to leave the auditorium.
